The Vision for Somerset: volunteers wanted

Introduction

The new County Plan was today agreed by Cabinet and is on track to be formally approved by Full Council next month.

A key part of the plan is the Vision for Somerset. It focuses on attracting more young people to the county, creating more jobs and building homes at affordable prices.

- A push on energy initiatives
- Business Parks to boost jobs and the local economy

These are ambitious projects that will take time to deliver and require the support and work of many partners and organisations, but we can be at the heart of driving them forward.
