## Changes to First West of England Bus Services in Somerset – 9 October 2022

With the end of the Local Transport Fund (LTF) funding from Central Government in early October 2022, bus operators have been reviewing their networks in the light of current lower levels of patronage on their bus services in Somerset, which continue to be around 65% to 70% of pre-covid levels. The Department for Transport have acknowledged this and tasked bus operators and Local Authorities to work together to adjust timetables to take account of the new travel patterns emerging from the pandemic.

First West of England who operate services in the Mendip and Sedgemoor areas of the County are now planning to make changes to their commercial services in the light of the removal of Central Government funding. We have now received their registrations, the details of which are set out in a summary table below.

These changes are due to come into effect on either Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> or Monday 10<sup>th</sup> October and reflect the levels of ongoing patronage they anticipate and the commercial viability of these services without LTF funding.

The notice period before these registrations can be implemented is seventy days (the first twenty-eight days of which are for consultation with Local Authorities) and we will be discussing these changes with both the operator and neighbouring authorities in the coming days.

Should there be any changes to the details below as a result of these discussions we will provide a further update in due course.

We are anticipating further changes from other Commercial Bus Operators in the County in the light of the withdrawal of LTF funding in October 2022 and we will provide further information as we receive registrations from local bus operators.
